 - "I was wondering if we can meet to discuss how I am doing."

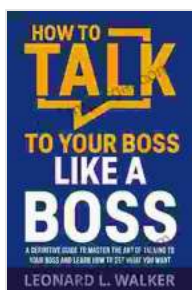

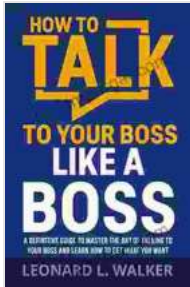

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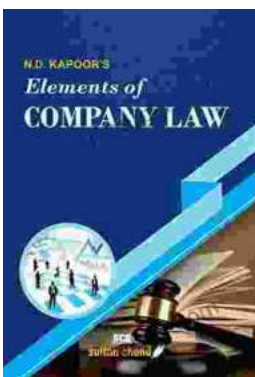


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
